- Estimates for cultivated areas vary considerably. Van Arkadie (1977: 129) cites 610,000 dunums for cereals, and 580,000 for olives (for the year 1973); Artzi (Department of Agriculture, 1980:9-11) suggests 437,000 dunums for cereals and 875,000 for orchards (1978 no break-down for olives is given); Dajani (Department of Agriculture, 1980:2) gives 700,000 dunums for cereals and 700,000 for olives; Bull (1975: 67) gives 600,000 dunums for olives, and no figures for cereals.
- 2. Farm surveys carried out by the Central Bureau of Statistics merely

ask the respondents about "the area at their disposal and its utilization, orchards by number of trees and year of planting, the use of labour force, selected employment inputs and various demographic data" (CBS-MSOAT, 1971:XVI).
